Things are recycled locally, ie, within the United States, so the safety of the recyclers is protected as they work with the hazardous materials. Any computer which can be reintroduced into use, is, with open source software. I've taken cordless phones, cable boxes and other electronic stuff I've recovered from rentals I've worked in, so they seem to be ok with just about anything electronic. Go to the website for times and directions for recycling your electronics. As I look at what they accept, they might not accept all electronics, but it's always worth a try. They charge \$10 per CRT
